The Nassau County Executive's Task Force on Family Violence (FVTF) 2017 Many Faces of Family Violence Conference

The 7th annual Many Faces of Family Violence Conference will be a full day of workshops related to various facets of interpersonal violence. The Conference attracts social workers, human services practitioners, psychologists, Child Protective Services caseworkers, law enforcement officers, teachers and school staff, juvenile justice workers and counselors. Proposals should be for 90-minute workshops which are eligible for Social Work Continuing Education Credit.

GUIDELINES FOR WORKSHOP PROPOSAL SUBMISSIONS

All workshop proposal submissions will be reviewed by the Conference Committee based on the following criteria

- Relevance to the Conference theme
- Presenter's demonstrated expertise in the proposed subject area
- Clarity of the proposal and identified learning objectives
- Proposal's capacity for skill building
- Proposal's enhancement of community awareness regarding workshop subject

Potential topic areas may include:

- Domestic & Intimate Partner Violence
- Rape & Sexual Assault
- Child Abuse
- Human Trafficking
- Legal Services for Survivors
- Mental Health Services for Survivors and family members
- Substance abuse and trauma
- Systems awareness/education

Presentations that address the intersectionality of these issues with specific populations (i.e., LGBTQ, immigrant and lower socioeconomic populations) or specific subtopics within the larger issues (i.e., technology and domestic violence) are encouraged.

WORKSHOP PROPOSAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Please adhere to the following format:

- 1. Full name, credentials, title, organization, address, phone, fax, and e-mail of each presenter
- 2. Brief biography (50 word limit) for each presenter
- 3. The title of the presentation
- 4. Abstract (50 word limit)
- 5. 3 learning objectives (50 word limit)
- 6. Proposal Text (800 word limit)
- 7. References
- 8. Full CV
